

Curriculum Dinner Coordinator Volunteer Description:

Goal: To cook a healthy, delicious, affordable meal for about 75 people.

We need volunteers, preferably to work in pairs, to cook a small meal for our Habitat for Humanity Curriculum Classes. These 10 classes are held on various Tuesday nights throughout the months of October through March. Habitat will provide a grocery store gift card to cover the cost of the food.

Requirements: Must be able to cook for a large group on a minimal budget.

We would prefer each “volunteer cooking duo” take on making a meal for at least 3 classes.

All meals must be healthy and contain a protein and vegetables.

Volunteers will need to prepare food at their home and then deliver food to class location.

A firm commitment requested once signed up.

Outcome: Meals should be simple and easy to prepare. We would like to have a recipe of each meal and to have a cost basis of ingredients to share with class participants in order to continue sharing the lessons of fiscal responsibility and healthy living with homeowners.
