### Habitat for Humanity Tucson to Celebrate Completion of Amado Home *Single Father to Receive Keys at Dedication Event*

**WHAT:** After months of hard work, Habitat for Humanity Tucson will celebrate the completion of the Lopez family home in Amado.

Over the past year, Juan Lopez, a single father with two sons, has worked hard to complete his 200 hours of sweat equity volunteer time and save for a down payment; two basic requirements for all Habitat homeowners.

When asked how he felt when he learned he was going to get a Habitat home, Lopez said: "Ecstatic. It was an immense joy. Right after hanging up the phone, the kids and I started jumping around, laughing, until we got tired and finally huddled in a family hug."

Lopez will purchase his Habitat home with a no-interest mortgage provided through Habitat for Humanity Tucson. His payments, like those from all Habitat homeowners, will go into a fund to help Habitat Tucson build more homes.
